

**Overview of suitable evidence¹ of English language proficiency
for an English-language bachelor's degree programme
at the University of Wuppertal**



Language level B2

1. Proof by university entrance qualification (school certificate)

At least (min.) B2 level and at least 4 points/at least grade 4 *or*

Proof of successful completion of secondary school in an English-speaking country (Australia, Canada (except Quebec and New Brunswick), USA (high school diploma), British and international GCE A-level certificates, Irish Leaving Certificate, New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement, Scottish Qualifications Certificate)

2. Proof documented by providing the results of a recently passed language test with one of the certificates listed below

TOEFL iBT (Internet based, 0-120 points) with at least 72 points

TOEFL Essentials (Internet based, 0-12 points) with at least 8.0 points

TOEFL (Paper based, 310-677 points) with at least 543 points

TOEIC Listening and Reading with at least 785 points *and* Speaking 160 points *and* Writing 150 points²

IELTS with at least grade 5.5

Cambridge English Language Assessment (The CEFR level is always used as a reference):

Cambridge First Certificate in

English + Grade B or C (FCE);

Cambridge Preliminary English

Test + Result Distinction (PET);

Cambridge English: Business

Vantage (BEC Vantage)

¹All proofs must not be older than two years at the time of enrollment. Both online and in-person formats are accepted. Adult education center certificates are not accepted as proof.

²All 4 modules (completed as double modules if applicable) must be available.

Other certificates not listed here are subject to individual review.

3. Proof by study abroad/professional or student stays abroad/native speaker

At least one year of study in an English-speaking country (if the studies were completed in the respective country: Australia, Great Britain, Ireland, Canada (except Quebec and New Brunswick), New Zealand, USA) Proof through transcripts, certificates, etc.

At least one year of study abroad in an English-speaking country (proof through transcripts, certificates, etc.)

At least one year of professional experience in an English-speaking country and B2 language skills (proof through employer certificate)

4. Persons who cannot provide any of the evidence listed in Nos. 1-3

Proof of B2 English language proficiency can be provided by means of an English-language technical interview at the department.⁴

³ All 4 individual exams of the IGCSE 1st or 2nd Language must be available and passed.

⁴ Interested parties should contact the respective department themselves to arrange an appointment for an interview. The department will inform the Student Secretariat (studsek@uni-wuppertal.de) of the outcome of the English-language interview as soon as possible after the interview.
